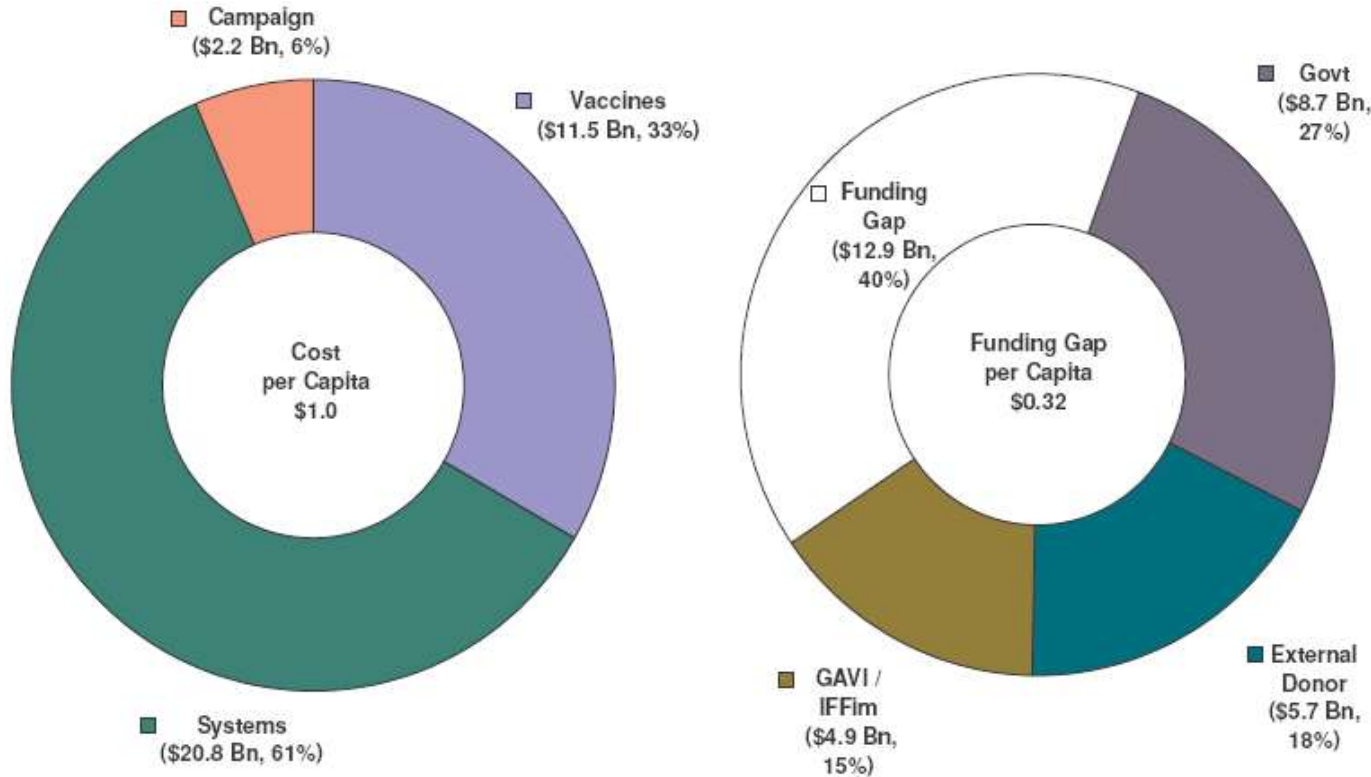

The GAVI Alliance strategic goals

1. Strengthening the capacity of the **health system** to deliver immunisation and other health services in a sustainable manner
2. Accelerate the uptake and use of **underused and new vaccines** and associated technologies and improve vaccine supply security
3. Increase the predictability and sustainability of long-term **financing** for national immunisation programmes
4. Increase the **added value** of GAVI as a public-private global health partnership through efficiency, advocacy and innovation

Global Immunisation Vision and Strategy: 61% of costs are systems related

10. Sustainability conscious

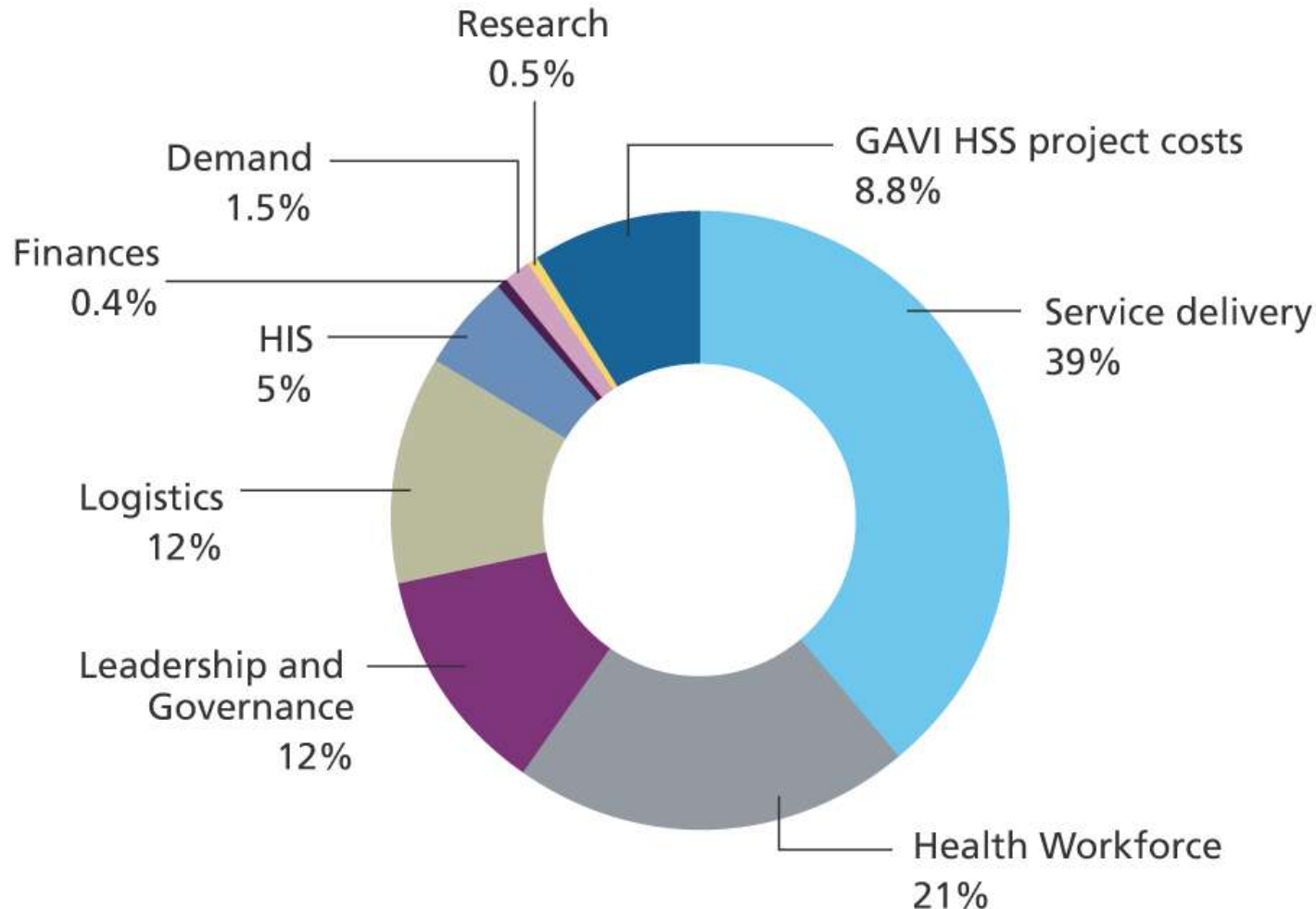


Analysis of 49 proposals (US\$ 427 million)

75% funding for 'operational' level (district and below)

16% funding for upstream level (above district)

9% management



Challenges looking forward

- General acceptance that building health services is key priority (IHP)
- Additional funding will be needed
- Need to explore innovative financing streams tied to health system development
- Results-based financing
- Country-specific results; Monitoring & Evaluation framework (MDG 4,5 and 6 metrics)
- Build on existing instruments and mechanisms; simplify architecture where possible
